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GUEST QUARTERS

- Five extraordinary guest quarters: 3 large suites and 2 spacious state rooms, dramatically restored, remodeled, refurbished, and uniquely decorated
- The guest quarters are named for significant eras of Newport history and decorated with art and artifacts of the people and periods
- Each guest room features at least 1 fireplace, 2-person whirlpool tub, king-size bed, antiques, period art, concealed media center with built-in speakers and iPod sound systems, marble bathing salons (some with steam showers), one-of-a-kind architectural surprises, air conditioning
- The "Above and Beyond" Suite is perhaps Newport's most luxurious guest room. This 1500 square foot suite--the entire third floor--has 5 rooms, replete with secret doors, hidden chambers, faux book library imported from England's Cotswolds, and Victorian bathing salon. It features unmatched private luxury

THE BUILDING & ITS HISTORY

- The Inn is a gracious Renaissance Style Victorian designed and built in 1866 by renowned Newport architect George Champlin Mason as a private home for prominent Newport banker and businessman James B. Finch
- The Inn was acquired by the Legendary Inns of Newport in 2001 and was extensively redesigned and remodeled in 2002 and 2003. The million dollar renovation reconfigured the 15 room house into just 5 deluxe guest quarters
- The Inn was named in honor of an unusual Newport woman of the Colonial era, Abigail Stoneman, who was Newport's first woman Inn owner and a remarkably ambitious and versatile businessperson for her day
- The Inn contains "Newport Women of a Certain Age," an art collection of some 75 paintings and prints featuring Newport's women, spanning more than 300 years

LOCATION

- Located in-town on prestigious Touro Street in the Historic Hill area, Abigail Stoneman Inn is within walking distance of most Newport attractions and two blocks from Newport's famous harbor front, with its many historic sites, restaurants, shops and galleries
- Within the block are historic Touro Synagogue (America's first synagogue), the Newport Historical Society (in one of Newport's famous old buildings) and other architecturally important historic buildings
- Two blocks north is Bellevue Avenue with its famed mansions, the International Tennis Hall of Fame, the Newport Art Museum, the Redwood Library (America's first) and more shops and restaurants
- Toward the harbor front, nearby historic pre-revolutionary war Trinity Church overlooks the hustle and bustle of Thames Street, Brick Market, Bowen's and Bannister's Wharfs
- 3.5 hour drive from New York City, 1.5 from Boston.
